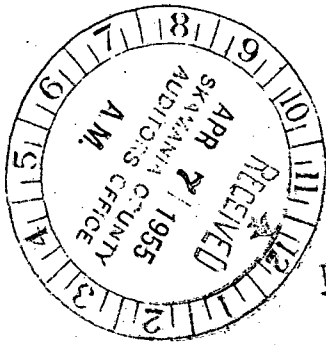

WARRANTY DEED

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That Moffetts Hot Springs Co., a Corporation, grantor, for valuable consideration hereby convey of North Bonneville, Washington, and warrant to The Christian Science Society, grantee, the following described real property situated in Skamania County, Washington, to-wit:

Beginning at a point that is 801.10 feet South and 919.18 feet West from the North East corner of Section 21, Township 2 North, Range 7 East of the Willamette Meridian in Skamania County, Washington; thence North 79° 51' West a distance of 356.49 feet to the true point of beginning; thence North 0° 48' West a distance of 100 feet; thence South 79° 51' East a distance of 100 feet; thence South 0° 48' East a distance of 100 feet; thence North 79° 51' East a distance of 100 feet to the point of beginning known on the unrecorded plat of North Bonneville as Lots 6 and 7 of Block 11. Except such portion of Lot 6 as is used for a street.
