

PARTIAL RELEASE OF MORTGAGE

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS that the BANK OF STEVENSON, a corporation, the owner and holder of that certain mortgage bearing date of March 24, 1962, executed by A. R. ADAMS, to secure the payment of \$4,538.40 and interest, which mortgage was duly recorded in the office of the auditor of Skamania County, Washington, on March 28, 1962, under auditor's File No. 59698, Book 39 of Mortgages, at page 230, for value received, does hereby release and discharge from the lien of said mortgage the following described portion of such mortgage to premises, situated in Skamania County, Washington, to-wit:

That portion of the S. M. Hamilton Donation Land Claim in Section Twenty (20), Township Two (2) North, Range 7 East of the Willamette Meridian, described as follows: Beginning at the intersection of the Northerly shore of Greenleaf Slough with the Easterly line of the said Hamilton Donation Land Claim; thence South 17°30' East along the Easterly line of said Donation Land Claim to the Northerly right of way line of Primary State Highway No. 8; thence Westerly along the Northerly line of said Highway 240 feet; thence North 17°30' West parallel to the Easterly line of said Donation Land Claim to a point on the Northwestern shore of said Greenleaf Slough; thence Northeasterly along the Northwestern shore of said Greenleaf Slough to the point of beginning.

This partial release shall not impair or otherwise affect the lien of said mortgage as to the remaining lands therein described.
