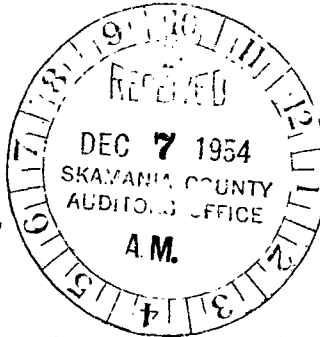

I, JANIE L. PORTER, being first duly sworn, depose and say:

I am the widow of Johnston P. Porter, who died on *the 19th August*, 1935. My former husband, Johnston P. Porter, was one of the original stockholders of Table Rock Mineral Water Company, an Oregon corporation, holding 600 shares of the stock of that corporation. Sometime prior to his death my husband gave the 600 shares of stock to me. I am not certain that the shares were ever transferred into my name on the company's books. In any event I have made a diligent search for the certificate if one was transferred into my name, and have been unable to find it. The shares were not included in my husband's estate at the time of the probate of that estate. It is my belief and representation that said 600 shares of stock and all stock assessments and other advances made by my husband with respect thereto were and are my sole property and that I am solely entitled to any distributions which may now be made of residual assets of Table Rock Mineral Water Company in satisfaction of the interest represented by said stock, stock assessments and advances.

In consideration of the payment to me of any distribution from the residual assets of Table Rock Mineral Water Company

attributable to the above-described stock interest and interest in stock assessments and advances, I agree for myself, my heirs and assigns, to indemnify and save harmless Table Rock Mineral Water Company, its surviving officers and directors, and its agents and attorneys from and against any loss, costs, expenses, damages or liability which may at any time be asserted against them or any of them by reason of their payment of said distribution to me.
