WHEREAS it appears that the directors of the company at that time were Andrew R. Porter, David L. Skidmore, and Charles E. McCulloch; and

WHEREAS it appears that at the time of its dissolution and at the present time Table Rock Mineral Water Company owned and owns certain lands in Skamania County, Washington, hereinafter more particularly described; and

whereas at the time of its dissolution ten per cent of the outstanding stock of Table Rock Mineral Water Company was beneficially owned by Welch Investment Company, a corporation; and

whereas welch Investment Company has been liquidated and dissolved and all of the assets of the company distributed in undivided interests to its stockholders as follows:
