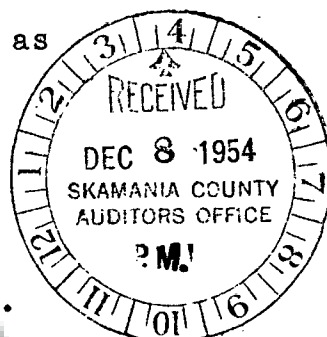


## QUITCLAIM DEED

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That INMAN-POULSEN LUMBER COMPANY, a corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of Oregon, in consideration of One Dollar (\$1.00) to it paid by DICK R. HASKIN, a single person, does hereby remise, release and forever quitclaim unto the said Dick R. Haskin, a single person, his heirs and assigns, all its right, title and interest in and to the following described real property, with the timber, tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances, situated in the County of Skamania, State of Washington, bounded and described as follows, to-wit:

The Northeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter ( $NE\frac{1}{4}$  of  $NW\frac{1}{4}$ ), the West half of the Northeast Quarter ( $W\frac{1}{2}$  of  $NE\frac{1}{4}$ ); and the Northwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter ( $NW\frac{1}{4}$  of  $SE\frac{1}{4}$ ); all in Section 23, Township 3 North, Range 7 East, W.M.



TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same to the said Dick R. Haskin, a single person, his heirs and assigns, forever.

WHEREAS, the said Dick R. Haskin, a single person, has completely performed under that certain contract dated the 20th day of June, 1952, and in accordance therewith Inman-Poulsen Lumber Company has caused this Quitclaim Deed to be made.
