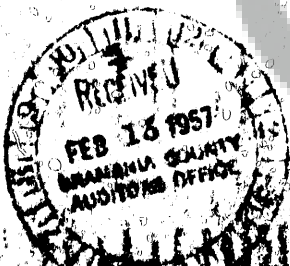


YOUNG, husband and wife, of Camas, Washington, for and in consid-

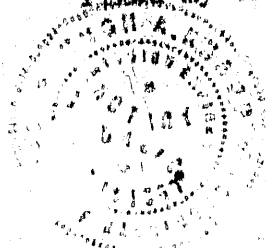
