THIS AGREEMENT, made and entered into by and between the **SEATTLE RAILWAY COMPANY**, a corporation, hereinafter called the "Railway Company", and **STATE OF WASHINGTON**, Highway Department, hereinafter called the "State".

WITNESSETH

THAT, the parties hereto, under date of September 23, 1948, entered into an agreement of lease covering an irregular tract of land containing approximately 1.3 acres situate upon the northerly portion of Railway Company right of way in the Southwest Quarter of Section 28, Township 1 North, Range 8 East of Willamette Meridian near Canyon Station, Blaine County, Washington, as a site for stockpiling of sand material.

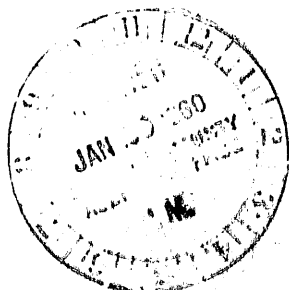
WHEREAS, by lease extension agreement dated October 2, 1948 said agreement of lease was extended for an additional 5-year period ending September 1, 1959; and the parties hereto desire to extend said lease for a further 5-year period.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the covenants herein contained the parties hereto agree as follows:

1. Said agreement of lease dated September 23, 1948 shall be and is hereby extended for a 5-year period commencing September 1, 1959 to and including August 31, 1964; subject to ninety day written notice of cancellation by either party.
2. As rental for said extended 5-year period the lessee agrees to pay to the Railway Company the sum of fifty dollars (\$50.00), payable in advance, for the full term of this extension agreement.
3. Except as hereby amended, all of the terms and conditions contained in said lease agreement of September 23, 1948 shall remain unchanged.

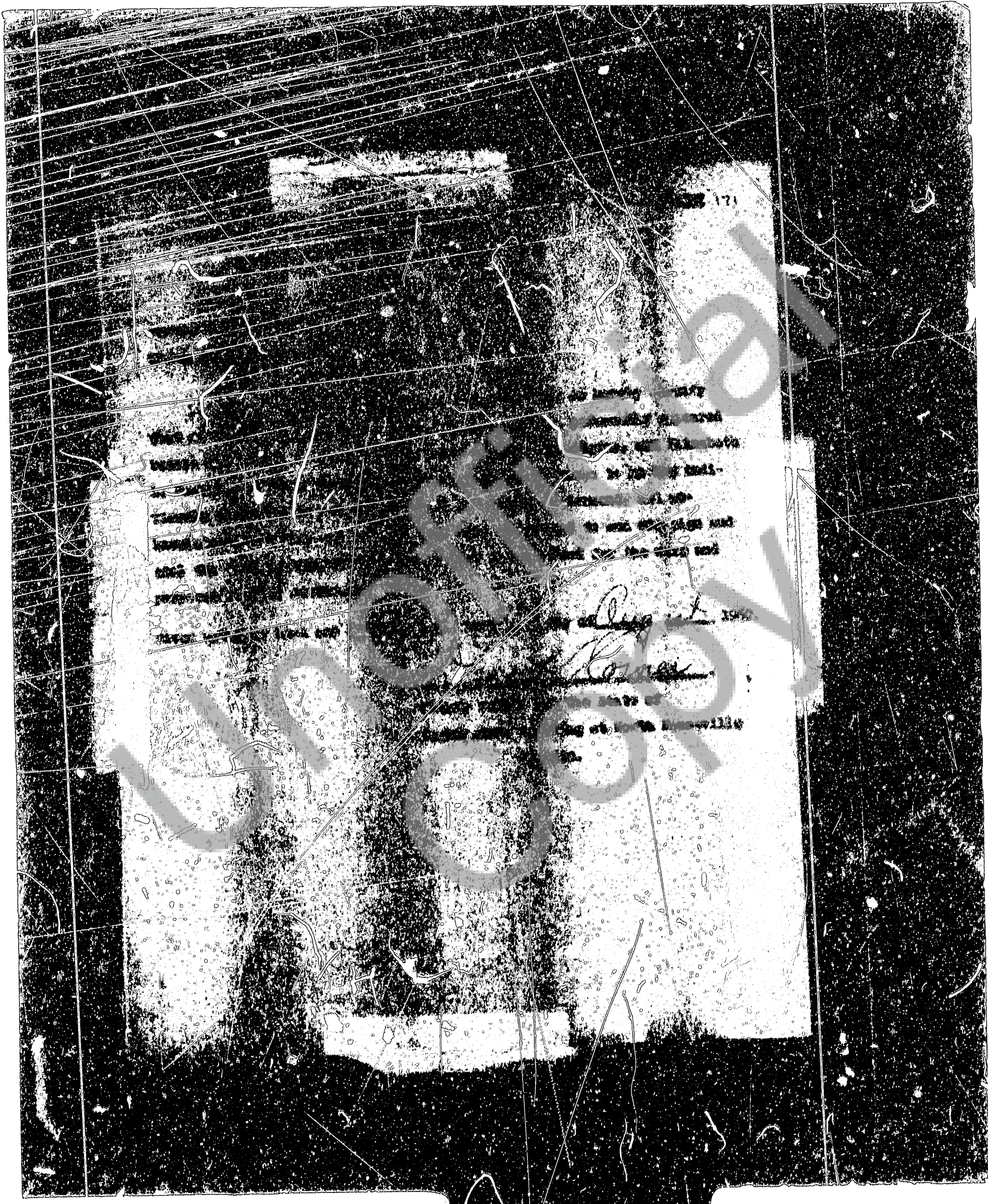
