

QUITCLAIM DEED

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS that Pacific Power & Light Company, a Maine corporation, in consideration of the sum of One and 00/100 Dollars (\$1.00), to it in hand paid, does hereby remise, release and forever quitclaim unto the record owners of the real property hereinafter described, and to their heirs, successors and assigns, except as hereinafter specifically reserved, all of its right, title and interest in and to the following described real property situated in Skamania County, Washington, to wit:

Government Lot Six (6) in Section 27, Township 3 North,  
Range 8 East of W.M.

an easement in and over which said real property (and other real property) was granted and conveyed to Northwestern Electric Company (to which said Pacific Power & Light Company is now successor in interest) by Thomas H. Monaghan and Margaret Monaghan's certain right of way easement deed dated August 12, 1912, and recorded in Book 0 at Page 38 of the Deed Records of Skamania County, Washington, said Pacific Power & Light Company hereby specifically reserving all rights granted by said easement deed in and to all the real property covered thereby, except the real property hereinabove described.
