

EASEMENT

The Grantor, STEVENSON LUMBER COMPANY, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Washington, having its principal place of business at Stevenson, in Skamania County, Washington, for and in consideration of Ten Dollars and other Valuable Considerations in hand paid, hereby grants, bargains, sells and conveys to the Grantee, MILFORD H. LEATHERS, an easement over the existing private logging road as now constructed on and over the following described real property in Skamania County, Washington:

All real property in Sections 35 and 27, Township 3 North, Range 7 E.W.M., title to which stands in the name of Stevenson Lumber Company or of Carson Lumber Company.



Said easement shall be limited in its use by the grantee for the purpose of hauling logs and timber from the following described real property in Skamania County, Washington:

The South Half of the Southeast Quarter (S $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 28, Township 3 North, Range 7 E.W.M.;

and the said easement is limited for a period of one year from the date hereof and shall automatically terminate on October 12, 1956; and the said easement shall not be assigned except with the written consent of the grantor.

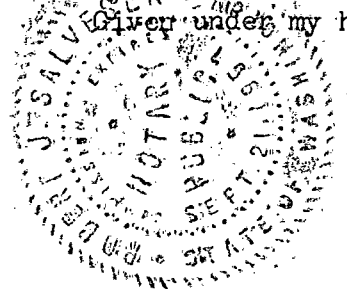
