NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the above named Plaintiff has commenced an action in the above entitled Court against the above named Defendants; and the purpose of said action is to procure a judgment against the Defendants, VONNIE C. HARVEY and EDITH LELIA HARVEY, husband and wife, on a Promissory Note in the sum of \$5300.00, plus interest at 5% per annum thereon, from December 17, 1955; and his interest on the sum of \$240.00 delinquent interest in the sum of 12% per annum since December 17, 1955; and for \$500.00 attorneys' fees if there shall be no contest, and \$1,000.00 if the same shall be contested; and for Plaintiff's costs; and to foreclose a mortgage securing the payment of said Promissory Note upon the following described property, to-wit:
