



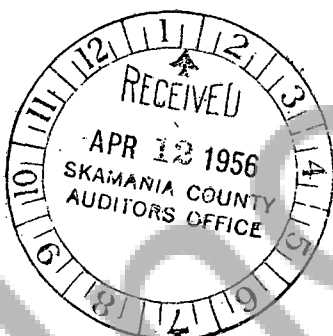
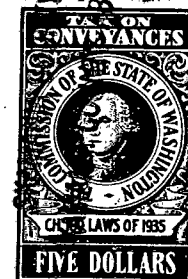
## WARRANTY DEED
