



THIS AGREEMENT made and entered into by and between Louis Thun, party of the first part, and Emily Thun, party of the second part, WITNESSETH:

That the parties hereto are husband and wife residing in the state of Washington and are the owners of community property therein.

That it is our desire to provide by contract for the disposition of said property upon the death of either of us. Therefore, it is agreed between us as follows:

1. All property now owned by us situate in the state of Washington is community property and all property which may be acquired by us, or either of us, hereafter whether acquired through gift, devise, inheritance, or otherwise, shall become and be considered by us as our community property without any further or separate agreement or deed being necessary to convert separate property and the same shall be governed by the terms of this agreement.

2. Upon the death of either of us all of our said community property shall go to and vest in the survivor.
