

PARTIAL RELEASE OF MORTGAGE

This release, however, shall not impair the validity of the said mortgage as to the other real property therein described.

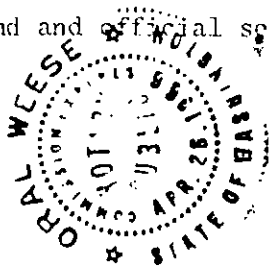
