

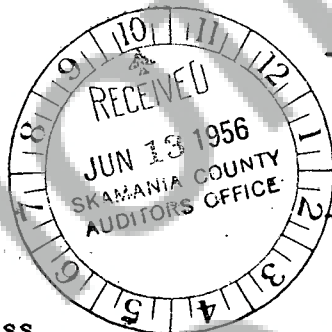
QUIT CLAIM DEED

THE GRANTORS, CHARLES COOVERT and NINA COOVERT, husband and wife, for and in consideration of the sum of One dollar (\$1.00) in hand paid, does hereby convey and Quit Claim unto RICHARD WANTLAND and JOSEPHINE WANTLAND, husband and wife, all interest in and to the following described real property, situate in Skamania County, Washington, to-wit:

The Southwest quarter of the Northeast quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Thirty-four (34), Township Two (2) North, Range 5 East of the Willamette Meridian.

GRANTORS RETAIN the right to use the logging road crossing said property and retain the right to remove the timber thereon, both for a period of Five (5) years from this date. Upon the expiration of said 5 year period Grantor's rights in said land shall thereupon cease.
