thence follow the center line of said S.P. & S. Railway north 58° 18′ west 392.0 feet; thence north 31° 42′ east to the low water line of the Columbia River; thence along said low water line southeasterly to an intersection with a line extended north 1° 17′ west from the place of beginning; thence along this extended line south 1° 17′ east to the place of beginning, excert all the included portions of said S.P. & S. Railway right of way.
