hereby convey and warrant to the State of Washington, the following described real estate situated in SKAMANIA County, in the State of Washington:

A strip of land 150 feet in width, being 75 feet wide on each side of the center line of Secondary State Highway No. 8-C, Wind River Bridge Vicinity, as surveyed over and across the Southwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ -NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section 1, Township 2 North, Range 7 $\frac{1}{2}$  East of the Willamette Meridian.

The lands being herein conveyed contain an area of 3.57 acres, more or less, the specific details concerning all of which are to be found within that certain map of definite location now of record and on file in the office of the Director of Highways at Olympia and bearing date of approval April 17, 1956, and the center line of which is also shown of record in Book "A" of Highway Plats, page 6 and 7, records of said county.

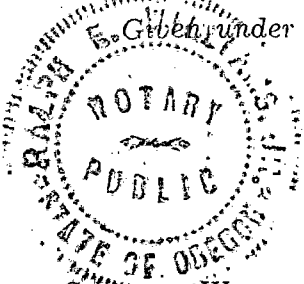
