KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That the Grantors

William E. Dame and Agnes N. Dame, husband and wife on September 22, 1952, and all time since

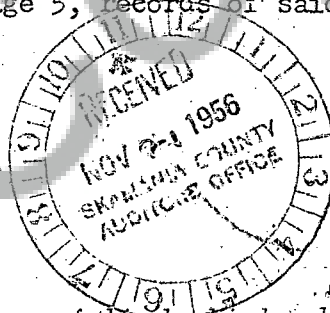
for and in consideration of the sum of -----Ten(\$10.00)and no/100----- Dollars, and other valuable consideration

hereby convey and warrant to the State of Washington, the following described real estate situated in Skamania County, in the State of Washington:

All that portion of the following described Parcel "A" lying North-easterly of a line drawn parallel with and 75 feet distance South-westerly when measured at right angles from the center line of Secondary State Highway No. 8-C, Wind River Bridge Vicinity.

PARCEL "A": A strip of land 50 feet in width situated in Section 7, Township 3 North, Range 8 E.W.M., described as follows: Commencing at the northwest corner of the northeast quarter of the northwest quarter of the said Section 7; thence south 50 feet; thence east to intersection with State Road No. 8-C; thence northerly along the westerly line of the said road to intersection with the north line of the said Section 7; thence west along the north line of the said Section 7 to place of beginning.

The lands being conveyed herein contain an area of 700.0 square feet, more or less the specific details concerning all of which are to be found within that certain map of definite location now of record and on file in the office of the Director of Highways at Olympia and bearing date of approval April 17, 1956 and Revised July 10, 1956, and the center line of which is also of record in Volume "A" of Highways Plats, Page 5, records of said County.

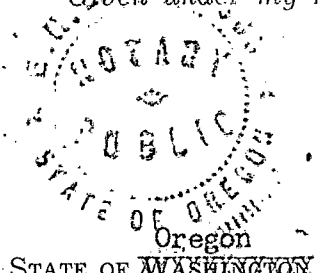
