In re: Applications Nos. 23627, 23628, 23631, 23632, 23633, 23634, 23635, 23636 and 23637 by Pacific Power and Light Company for Right to Overflow Certain State Land in Skamania County.

ORDER

December 20, 1956

It appearing to the Commissioner at this time that applications as shown in the following schedule have been filed in this office by Pacific Power and Light Company for right to overflow State land in Skamania County, the application number and complete description being shown:

> Application No. 23627 - Those portions of the $S_2^{\frac{1}{2}}SE_4^{\frac{1}{4}}$ and $SE_4^{\frac{1}{4}}SW_4^{\frac{1}{4}}$, Section 22, Township 7 North, Range 5 East, W.M., owned by the State of Washington, lying below the 1010 foot elevation, referred to mean sea level datum, and containing an area of 25.56 acres, more or less, as shown on the map thereof on file in the office of the Commissioner of Public Lands at Olympia, Washington.

> Application No. 23628 - Those portions of Government Lots 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 8, 9 and 10, NW4SW4, NNNEL, SW4SE4 and SASW4, Section 26, Township 7 North, Range 5 East, W.M., owned by the State of Washington lying below the 1010 foot elevation, referred to mean sea level datum and containing an area of 336.63 acres, more or less, as shown on the map thereof on file in the office of the Commissioner of Public Lands at Olympia, Washington.

Application No. 23631 - Those portions of the NaNW and SW NW Section 34, Township 7 North, (Range 5 East, W.M., owned by the State of Washington,) lying below the 1010 foot elevation, referred to mean sea level datum and containing an area of 29.24 acres, more or less, as shown on the map thereof on file in the office of the Commissioner of Public Lands at Olympia, Washington.

Application No. 23632 - Those portions of Government Lots 1, 2, 3 and 4, NW NW, SELSEL, SELNW and SELNE, Section 36, Township 7 North, Range 5 East, W.M., owned by the State of Washington, lying below the 1010 foot elevation, referred to mean sea level datum and containing an area of 74,44 acres, more or less, as shown on the map thereof on file in the office of the Commissioner of Public Lands at

Olympia, Washington.

East, W.M., owned by the State of Washington, lying below the 1010 foot elevation referred to mean sea level datum, and containing an area of 18.94 acres, more or less, as shown on the map thereof on file in the office of the Commissioner of Public Lands at Olympia, Washington.

Application No. 23634: Those portions of the Sarand SEANE, Section 30. Township 7 North, Range 6 East, W.M., owned by the State of Washington, lying below the 1010 foot elevation, referred to mean sea level datum, and containing an area of 278.88 acres, more or less, as shown on the map thereof on file in the office of the Commissioner of Public Lands at Olympia, Washington.

Application No. 23635 - Lots 3 and 4. Section 32, Township 7 North, Range 6 East, W.M., with an area of 95.50 acres according to the plat thereof on file in the office of the Commissioner of Public Lands at Olympia, Washington.

Application No. 23636 - Those portions of Government Lots 1, 2, 3 and 4 and the N2N2, Section 34, Township 7 North, Range 6 East, W.M., owned by the State of Washington lying below the 1010 foot elevation referred to mean sea level datum, and containing an area of 233.34 acres, more or less, as shown on the map thereof on file in the office of the Commissioner of Public Lands at Clympia, Washington.

Application No. 23637 - All of the bed and shore lands of Lewis River, owned by the State of Washington, through Sections 25, 26, 27, 36 and the Eg of Section 28, Township 7 North, Range 5 East, W.M., and Section 26, 31, 32, 33, 34 and 35, Township 7 North, Range 6 East, W.M.

and

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It further appearing that the said applications were filed under the provisions of State law providing for the granting of the right to overflow State land; that the applications were filed in connection with a hydro-electric power project and the amount of damage resulting to the State by the exercise of the right to overflow and for perpetual use of the land applied for under said applications does not exceed the sum of \$766.80 under Application No. 23627; \$10,098.90 under Application No. 23628; \$877.20 under Application No. 23631; \$2,233:20 under Application No. 23632; \$568.20 under Application No. 23633; \$8,366.40 under Application No. 23634; \$2,865.00 under Application No. 23635; \$7,000.20 under Application No. 23636; and \$19,440.00 under Application No. 23637; and

It further appearing that on the areas covered by the said applications there is timber involved which will be destroyed in such use; that in connection with all of said applications, Nos. 23627, 23628, 23631, 23632, 23633, 23634, 23635, 23636 and 23637, Pacific Power and Light Company agrees to pay the State of Washington the total sum of any amounts received from the sale of timber under the said applications with the minimum to be \$1,249,759.00; that the payment for the use of the land and for timber located thereon is limited to the area below the 1000 foot elevation referred to mean sea level datum and the grant herein made is with the understanding that the overflow right will extend to the 1010 foot elevation with the further understanding that no rights for use or for any timber are to be exercised on that area between the 1000 foot and 1010 foot elevations and the Pacific Power and Light Company will be held responsible to the State for any damage caused to the land or timber within that area should any damage occur; and

agrees to furnish this office with maps showing the project boundaries from which metes and bounds descriptions of the overflow area may be prepared; that when said maps are submitted a new order describing the area by metes and bounds will be issued in lieu of this order and adjustment for any differences in acreage developed by the new maps can be made when a final order is executed; and the Commissioner being fully advised and believing that the applications should be granted, it is therefore

ORDERED and DETERMINED that the value of the land included in the applications, Nos. 23627, 23628, 23631, 23632, 23633, 23634, 23635, 23636 and 23637, together with the damages to or upon the land remaining and including all damages suffered by the State in granting the right to overflow under said applications be and the same is hereby fixed at the figures as hereinabove set forth; that the total of said amounts shall be paid in cash by Pacific Power and

Light Company and in addition thereto, said company shall pay to the State the entire amount received from the sale of the timber on the overflow area but in no event less than the amount of \$1,249,759.00 as hereinabove set forth; that proper arrangements have been made for the payment for the right to everflow and for payment for the timber as hereinabove set forth and the right to overflow the lands covered by Applications Nos. 23627, 23628, 23631, 23632, 23633, 23634, 23635, 23636 and 23637, as hereinabove more particularly described, may be exercised in accordance with the statutes.

PROVIDED that Pacific Power and Light Company agrees that it will be responsible for any damage to State land or timber should the reservoir level reach an elevation of 1010 feet referred to mean sea level datum and to be responsible for payment for any timber cut or destroyed on the area between the 1000 foot and the 1010 foot elevations.
