Right To Use Power Line Easement And Right-of-Way

The UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, Department of the Interior, acting through the Bonneville Power Administrator, pursuant to 16 U.S.C. 832 et seq., for and in consideration of the payment of all costs incident to relocation of electric power line structures within the boundaries of its easement and right-of-way for the Bonneville Power Administration McNary-Ross line, does hereby release unto the State of Washington, the servient owner, the right, license and privilege to construct, use and maintain the relocated secondary state highway No. 8-C upon 150-foot highway right-of-way, Wind River vicinity, upon the easement and right-of-way for said McNary-Ross line at an angle of $50^{\circ}30'$ or on a bearing of South $39^{\circ}07'10''$ West at State Highway Engineer's Station 148+21 - BPA Survey Station 7445.49.6, in a portion of the E $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 17, Township 3 North, Range 8 East of the Willamette Meridian, Skamania County, Washington.

The UNITED STATES OF AMERICA agrees to withhold the construction of electric power transmission facilities upon that part of the highway right-of-way as presently located across the McNary-Ross right-of-way as long as the highway right-of-way is maintained and used by the State of Washington as a public highway.

The State of Washington agrees that the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA retains the right to span secondary highway No. 8-C at the point of crossing with electric power transmission conductors (wires) in any manner that will not interfere with its use for public highway purposes.

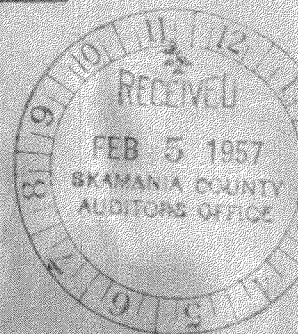

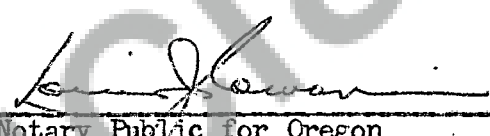
