for and in consideration of the sum of One hundred seventy-five & No/100 Dollars, in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby convey and warrant unto the STATE OF WASHINGTON the right, privilege and permit of ingress and egress over and across the hereinafter described lands for a haul road to conveniently transport highway materials and equipment, at any and all times from date hereof until February 7 19 62, said lands being situated in Skamania County, State of Washington, and described as follows:

The North 30 feet of the following described Parcel "A";

PARCEL "A":

Beginning at the center of Section 17, Township 3 North, Range 8 E. W. M., thence South 89° 55' East 30 feet to the initial point of the tract hereby described; thence South 89° 55' East 250 feet; thence South 172 feet; thence Westerly to a point 172 feet South of the initial point; thence North 172 feet to the initial point; said tract containing one acre, more or less.

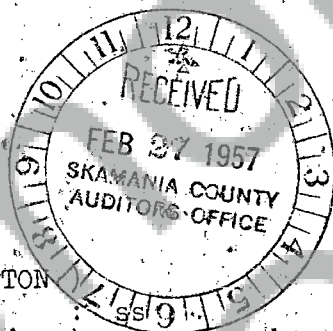
It is understood that this lease shall be in force for a period of five (5) years from the date hereof, or until such time as construction of said highway is completed, whichever date is earlier.
