hereby conveys and warrants to the State of Washington, the following described real estate situated in Skamania County, in the State of Washington:

All that portion of the following described Parcel "A" lying Easterly of a line drawn parallel with and 75 feet distance Westerly when measured at right angles and or radially from the center line of Secondary State Highway No. 8-C, Wind River Bridge Vicinity.

PARCEL "A":

Beginning at the Northeast corner of the West Half of the Northeast Quarter ($W\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 20, Township 3 North, Range 8 E.W.M.: thence south 347 feet; thence west 239 feet; thence north 347 feet; thence east 239 feet to the point of beginning.

The lands being conveyed herein contain an area of 0.33 acres, more or less the specific details concerning all of which are to be found within that certain map of definite location now of record and on file in the office of the Director of Highways at Olympia and bearing date of approval April 17, 1956, and the center line of which is also of record in Volume "A" of Highways Plats, Page 1, records of said County.

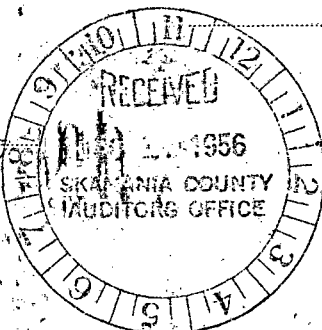
