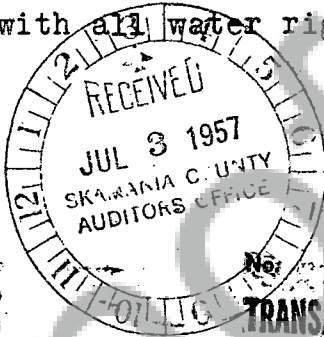
FOR PROPERTY WITHIN THE STATE OF WASHINGTON

That portion of the West Half of the Southwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter ( $W\frac{1}{2} SW\frac{1}{4} NW\frac{1}{4}$ ), and of the West Half of the East Half of the Southwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter ( $W\frac{1}{2} E\frac{1}{2} SW\frac{1}{4} NW\frac{1}{4}$ ), of Section 14, Township 4 North, Range 7 E.W.M., described as follows:

Beginning at a point 990 feet north and 20 feet east from the quarter corner on the west line of said Section 14; thence north 210 feet; thence east 970 feet; thence south 210 feet; thence west 970 feet to the point of beginning.

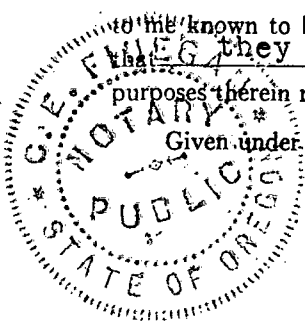
