

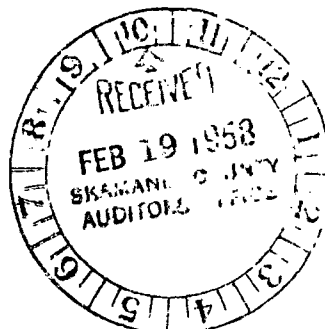

ASSIGNMENT

For and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and of other good and valuable consideration, the receipt of all of which is hereby acknowledged, HARBOR PLYWOOD CORPORATION, a Delaware corporation (hereinafter called "Harbor"), does hereby ASSIGN, TRANSFER and SET OVER unto INTERNATIONAL PAPER COMPANY, a New York corporation (hereinafter called "International"), that certain contract dated July 20, 1955, between Northwest Door Company, a Washington corporation, and Harbor and all Harbor's right, title and interest in, to and under said contract relating to a right to use the Northwest Door Company road over certain lands described in said contract for the purpose of logging, growing and harvesting timber, and other purposes specified therein.

Harbor covenants and agrees that it will perform all obligations and make all payments on its part required under said contract insofar as such obligations and payments shall have accrued up to, or shall arise from events occurring before, the date hereof, whether or not performance or payment thereof would otherwise be required prior to said date, and that it will indemnify International from any and all loss, damage or expense resulting from its failure to comply with its undertakings hereunder.

International, by its acceptance of this assignment, agrees to undertake the responsibilities and duties of Harbor under said contract arising on and after the date hereof, but International shall not be obligated to perform any obligation
