CONVEYANCE OF RIGHT OF WAY

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS that GEORGIA-PACIFIC PLYWOOD COMPANY, a Georgia corporation, hereinafter referred to as "Grantor," for a valuable consideration, the receipt and adequacy of which are hereby acknowledged, to it paid by PACIFIC POWER & LIGHT COMPANY, a Maine corporation, hereinafter referred to as "Grantee," does hereby convey and quitclaim unto said Grantee, its successors and assigns, all Grantor's right, title and interest in and to the right of way described in Certificate of Right of Way No. 1096 from the Commissioner of Public Lands, State of Washington, executed on the first day of March, 1948, and containing the following description:

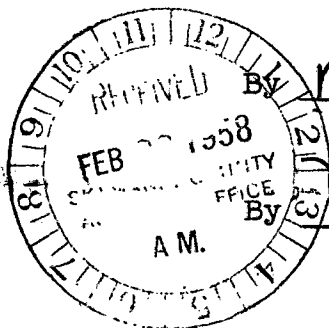
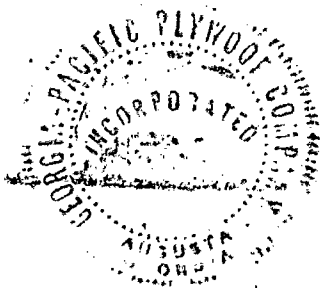
Those portions of the bed and shore lands of the north Fork of the Lewis River, owned by the State of Washington, between Lots 2 and 8, Section 29, Township 7 North, Range 5 East, Willamette Meridian, included within the limits of a strip 40 feet in width, having 20 feet of such width on each side of the following described center line:

Beginning at the south quarter section corner of said Section 29 and running thence N 9° 40' E 763.1 feet; thence north 4° 30' E 579.8 feet and thence on a 30° curve to the left, 246.7 feet, to a point on the center line of a county road in said Lot 2 and the terminal point of this description; according to the plat thereof on file in the office of the Commissioner of Public Lands at Olympia, Washington.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto Grantee, its successors and assigns.

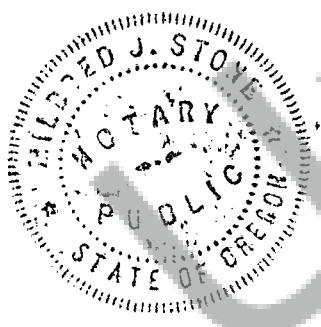
