COMMUNITY PROPERTY AGREEMENT

THIS COMMUNITY PROPERTY AGREEMENT made and entered into this 28 day of ______, 1947, by and between JOHN C.

BAARS and INEZ M. BAARS, husband and wife, both of Skamania County,

Washington:

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the parties hereto are the owners of certain property situate in the State of Washington, consisting of real and personal property, and whereas the parties contemplate acquiring more property in the future; and

WHEREAS, the parties are desirous of all of their community property passing to the survivor without delay or expense in the event of the death of either of them;

NOW THEREFORE, we, John C. Baars and Inez M. Baars do hereby mutually agree that all of the real estate owned by us in the State of Washington, all farm equipment, cattle, stock, bank accounts, notes receivable, household goods, furniture, and all United States war bonds which are in the name of both of us are and they hereby are declared to be community property. We recognize and agree that certain real estate situate in Terry, Montana, and the contract to sell certain land in Terry, Montana, and certain bonds issued in the name of Inez M. Baars and her daughter, Ramona Angus McAfee, and certain personal effects including clothing, linens, jewelry, bedding, dishes, are separate property of Inez M. Baars; and

We hereby mutually agree that all of the community property which will hereafter be acquired, as well as all the community property presently existing, shall be included in and covered by this community property agreement.
