ASSIGNMENT

For and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and of other good and valuable consideration, the receipt of all of which is hereby acknowledged, HARBOR PLYWOOD CORPORATION, a Delaware corporation, does hereby ASSIGN, TRANSFER and CONVEY unto INTERNATIONAL PAPER COMPANY, a New York corporation, that certain easement dated November 7, 1952 from O. H. Richter and Winona E. Richter, husband and wife, to Harbor Plywood Corporation to use so much of the following described real property, to-wit:

That portion of the Southeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Eighteen (18) in Township Seven (7) North, Range Six (6) East of the Willamette Meridian, which is bounded on the east by the east line of said legal subdivision and is enclosed on the south, west and north by a line beginning at a point 400.0 feet north 2°33' east of the east quarter corner of said Section Eighteen (18) and running thence north 7°27' west a distance of 137.0 feet to a point; and thence north 15°57' east a distance of 102.8 feet to a point on the east line of said Section Eighteen (18); which boundaries enclose an area comprising sixty-five one thousandths (0.065) of an acre, situated in Skamania County, Washington,

as may be necessary or convenient for all of the usual and customary purposes of keeping, maintaining, servicing, repairing, renewing and replacing an existing private truck logging road which lies over, upon, across and within the above-described premises.
