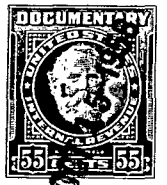
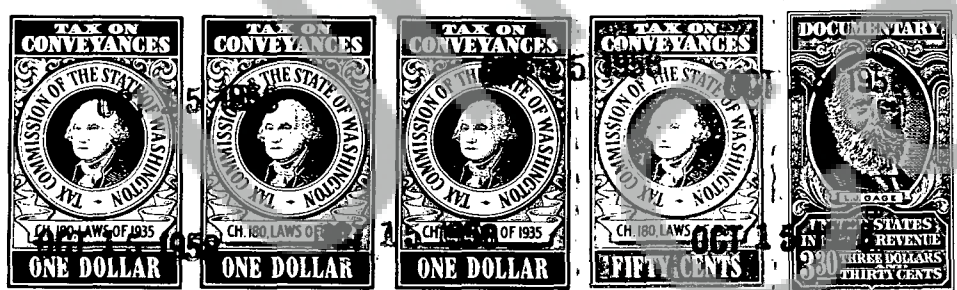

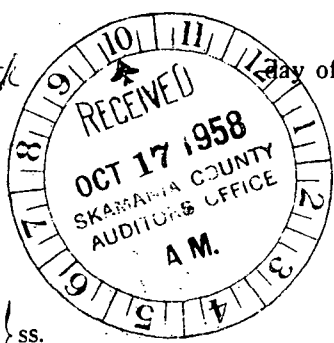
THE GRANTOR S RAY F. PARKER and GLADYS B. PARKER, husband and wife,
