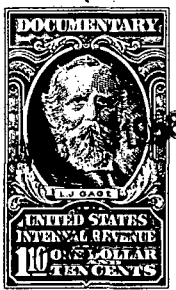


TIMBER DEED

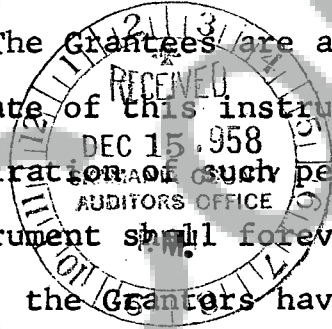
THE GRANTORS, PAUL J. VIAL and *Florence H. VIAL*, husband and wife, for and in consideration of the sum of One thousand four hundred dollars (\$1,400.00), the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby sell, assign and convey unto JOHN STEVENSON and RICHARD K. WANTLAND, the Grantees, all of the merchantible timber now standing, lying and being upon the following described real property situated in Skamania County, Washington, to-wit:



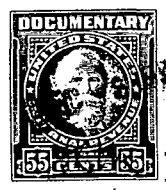
All of Government Lot Five (5) in Section Five (5), Township One (1) North, Range 6 East of the Willamette Meridian, and of the Southwest quarter of the Northeast quarter and Government Lots One (1) and Two (2) of Section Six (6), Township 1 North, Range 6 East of the Willamette Meridian, lying South of the Evergreen Highway (State Primary Road No. 8) and East of Archer Creek, except any portion thereof lying within the S.P. & S. Railway Company right-of-way.

1. Grantors warrants Grantee's title to said timber free and clear of all liens or encumbrances. Grantors further agree to execute such applications for timber cutting permits as shall be required for the removal of said timber.

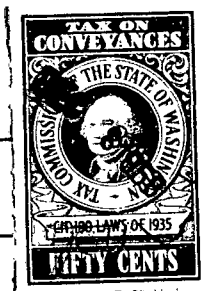
2. Grantees are accorded the right to use such roads on the above described lands and any other lands of Grantors for the purpose of the removal said timber. The Grantees are accorded the period of two calendar years from the date of this instrument in which to remove said timber, and upon the expiration of such period all rights of Grantees created by this instrument shall forever terminate.
