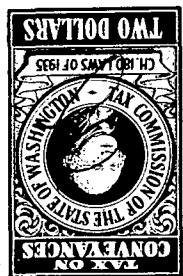
THE GRANTOR s, T. S. Applegate and Frances Applegate, husband and wife
