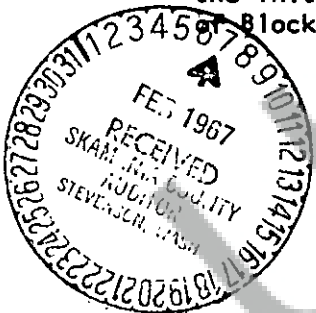
THE MORTGAGORS CHARLES W. THRAPP and DORIS I. THRAPP, husband and wife,
