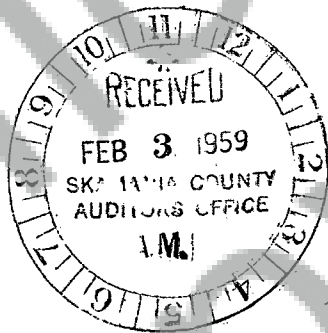
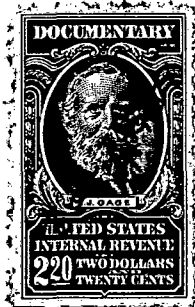


This Indenture Witnesseth, That I, Anna M. Breedlove, a widow,
