

SUBJECT to rights of Bonneville Power Administration for transmission line; and


SUBJECT to reservations of mineral rights by Prince Fay Dempsey and Ruth M. Dempsey in deed executed March 11th, 1958; and

SUBJECT to county roads or private rights of way.




