

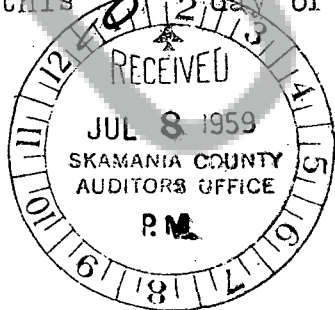
QUIT-CLAIM DEED

WHITLOCK and ZENABEE D. WHITLOCK, husband and wife, the following described real estate, situate in the County of Skamania, State of Washington:

Beginning at a point 450 feet north of the north line of State Highway No. 8 and 1574 feet west of the section line between Sections 21 and 22, Township 2 North, Range 7 East of the Willamette Meridian; thence north to shore of Bass Lake; thence westerly along shore of Bass Lake to point 100 feet west of last described line; thence south to point 450 feet north of north line of State Highway No. 8; thence easterly parallel to north line of said highway to point of beginning, containing one acre more or less;

SUBJECT to the reservation of Skamania County of the right to construct highways on and through the said property, free from all claims for damages or compensation as set forth in Tax Deed recorded under number 46506, page 426 of book 37, records of the Auditor, Skamania County.
