REAL ESTATE CONTRACT

THIS CONTRACT, made this 27th day of

August, 1959,

between

SHELDON E. BAXTER and LILLIAN BAXTER, husband and wife,

hereinafter called the "seller" and

ALLEN L. WARREN

hereinafter called the "purchaser,"

WITNESSETH: The seller agrees to sell to the purchaser, and the purchaser agrees to purchase of the

seller the following described real estate with the appurtenances, situate in Washington:

Skamania

County,

A ML

Commencing at a point 688 feet north of the southwest corner of the Northeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (NEt SEt) of Section 20, Township 3 North, Range 8 E. W. M.; thence east 437.5 feet, more or less, to the northwest corner of that certain tract of land conveyed to Ruben F. Grant and Evelyn Grant, husband and wife, by deed dated December 15, 1948, and recorded at page 259 of Book 32 of Beeds, Records of Skamania County, Washington; thence south 200 feet; thence west 437.5 feet to intersection with the west line of the northeast quarter of the south east quarter (NEt SEt) of the said Section 20; thence north 200 feet to the place of beginning; said tract of land containing 2 acres, more or less; EXCEPT right

This contract shall not be assigned by the purchaser without the illiment express written consent of the sellers, and any purported assemble ment without such consent shall be null and void. Pre-paid finer | VEU insurance premiums and 1959 taxes shall be pro-rated between the sellers and the purchaser as of September 1, 1959.

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In payment of a portion of the balance of the unpaid purchase price the purchaser agrees to assume and pay that certain mortgage made by Sheldon E. Baxter and Lillian Baxter, husband and wife, to Truman P. Price dated October 1, 1954, given to secure the principal sum of Three Thousand Five Hundred and No/100 (\$3,500.00) Dollars, which said mortgage has been assigned to J. C. Price and on which there remains unpaid the principal amount of Two Thousand Twenty-One and 08/100 (\$2,021.08) Dollars, plus interest from September 1, 1959.

The purchaser agrees to pay the remaining balance of the unpaid purchase price in the sum of Three Thousand Two Hundred Seventy-Eight and 92/100 (\$3,278.92) Dollars to the sellers in monthly installments as follows: \$40.00, or more, commencing on the first day of October, 1959, and on the first day of each and every month thereafter to and including the first day of November, 1961; and in monthly installments of \$50.00, or more, commencing on the first day of December, 1961, and on the first day of each and every month thereafter until the full amount of the unpaid purchase price, plus interest, shall have been paid. The monthly installments specified shall include interest at the rate of six per-cent (6%) per annum computed upon the monthly balances of the unpaid purchase price, and said installments shall be applied first to interest and then to principal. The purchasers reserve the right at any time while they are not in default under the terms and conditions of this contract to pay any part or all of the unpaid purchase price, plus interest, then due.

The purchaser agrees: (1) to pay before delinquency all payments of whatsoever nature, required to be made upon or by virtue of said mortgage, if any; also all taxes and assessments which are above assumed by him, if any, and all which may, as between grantor and grantee, hereafter become a lien on the premises; and also all taxes which may hereafter be levided or imposed upon, or by reason of, this contract or the obligation thereby evidenced, or any part thereof; (2) to keep the buildings now and hereafter placed upon the premises unceasingly insured against loss or damage by fire, to the full insurable value thereof, in the name of the seller as owner, in an insurance company satisfactory to the seller for the benefit of the mortgagee, the seller, and the purchaser, as their interests may appear, until the purchase price is fully paid, and to deliver to seller the insurance policies, renewals, and premium receipts, except such as are required to be delivered to the mortgagee; (3) to keep the buildings and all other improvements upon the premises in good repair and not to permit waste; and (4) not to use the premises for any illegal purpose.

In the event that the purchaser shall fail to pay before delinquency any taxes or assessments or any payments required to be made on account of the mortgage, or to insure the premises as above provided, the seller may pay such taxes and assessments, make such payments, and effect such insurance, and the amounts paid therefor by him shall be deemed a part of the purchase price and become payable forthwith with interest at the rate of 10 per cent per annum until paid, without prejudice to other rights of seller by reason of such failure.

The purchaser agrees to assume all risk of damage to any improvements upon the premises, or of the taking of any part of the property for public use; that no such damage or taking shall constitute a failure of consideration, but in case of such damage or taking, all moneys received by the seller by reason thereof shall be applied as a payment on account of the purchase price of the property, less any sums of money which the seller may be required to expend in procuring such money, or at the election of the seller, to the rebuilding or restoration of such improvements.

The seller agrees, upon receiving full payment of the purchase price and interest in the manner above spewarranty cified, to execute and deliver to purchaser a deed to the property,

excepting such part thereof which may hereafter be condemned, if any, free of incumbrances except those above mentioned, and any that may accrue hereafter through any person other than the seller.

The seller factories between the purchase price and deliver, to the purchaser, a title policy in usual form issued by the Puget Sound Title Insurance Company, insuring the purchaser to the full amount of said purchase price against loss or damage occasioned by reason of defect in, or incumbrance against, seller's title to the premises, not assumed by the purchaser, or as to which the conveyance hereunder is not to be subject.

The parties agree: (1) to execute all necessary instruments for the extension of payment or renewal of said mortgage during the period prior to the delivery of said deed, or the termination of purchaser's rights by virtue of the provisions hereof; provided the seller shall not be obligated thereby to assume any personal obligation or to execute any mortgage providing for a deficiency judgment against the seller, or securing a principal indebtedness in excess of that now unpaid on the above mentioned mortgage or bearing an interest rate of more than two per cent greater than that of the original mortgage indebtedness; (2) that the purchaser has made full inspection of the real estate and that no promise, agreement or representation respecting the condition of any building or improvement thereon, or relating to the alteration or repair thereof, or the placing of additional improvements thereon, shall be binding unless the promise, agreement or representation be in writing and made a part of this contract; (3) that the purchaser shall have possession of the real estate xxxx

immediately and be entitled to retain possession so long as purchaser is not in default in carrying out the terms hereof; and (4) that, upon default, forfeiture may be declared by notice sent by registered mail to the address of the purchaser, or his assigns, last known to the seller.

Time is of the essence hereof, and in the event the purchaser shall fail to comply with or perform any condition or agreement hereof promptly at the time and in the manner herein required, the seller may elect to declare all of the purchaser's rights hereunder terminated, and upon his doing so, all payments made by the purchaser hereunder and all improvements placed upon the premises shall be forfeited to the seller as liquidated damages, and the seller shall have the right to re-enter and take possession of the property; and if the seller within six months after such forfeiture shall commence an action to procure an adjudication of the termination of the purchaser's rights hereunder, the purchaser agrees to pay the expense of searching the title for the purpose of such action, together with all costs and a reasonable attorney's fee.
