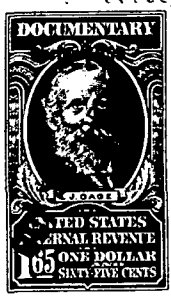

the following described real estate, situated in the County of Skamania, State of Washington:



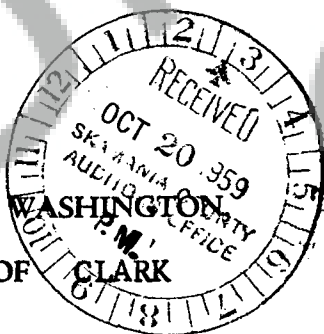
