WHEREAS the parties as husband and wife have acquired real and personal property within the State of Washington, and Oregon, are now the owners there of as a community, and

WHEREAS the said parties desire to provide for the disposition of said property upon the death of either, now therefore it is hereby agreed by and between the parties hereto that all property now owned by them or hereafter acquired by them, whether standing of record in the name of one or the other, or in the name of both, is and shall be considered as community property and estate of the parties hereto, and that upon the death of either of said parties all of said property shall immediately vest in and become the estate of the survivor.
