## Partial Release of Mortgage

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That COLUMBIA GORGE BANK, successor in interest to the Bank of Stevenson, the owner and holder of that certain mortgage bearing date the 1st day of June, 1964, executed by Charles L.
