ORDER

September 14, 1960

It appearing to the Commissioner of Public Lands at this time that Application No. 26239 has been filed in this office by Pacific Power and Light Company of Portland, Oregon, for an easement for right to overflow and inundate a portion of the S $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 16, Township 7 North, Range 5 East, W.M., in Skamania County; that said application was filed in accordance with the provisions of Section 102, Chapter 255 of the Session Laws of 1927, and the land affected by and included in the said application is more particularly described as follows:

That portion of the S $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 16, Township 7 North, Range 5 East, W.M., included in the following described tract:
 Beginning at a point on the South line of said Section 16 which is N 88° 58' 30" E 1,179.81 feet from the southwest corner thereof and running thence N 28° 30' W 182.83 feet, thence S 71° 01' 30" E 472.50 feet to a point on the south line of said Section 16 and thence S 88° 58' 30" W along said south line 360.42 feet to the point of beginning, having an area of 0.60 acre, as shown on the plat thereof on file in the office of the Commissioner of Public Lands at Olympia, Washington.

It further appearing that the amount of the damage resulting to the State by exercise of the right to overflow and inundate said land does not exceed the sum of \$25.00 for the use of the land and \$99.00 for the timber, or a total of \$124.00; and the Commissioner being fully advised, it is therefore

ORDERED and DETERMINED that the value of the land and timber included in said application, together with all damages to or upon the land remaining and including all damages suffered by the State by the overflowing and inundation of the lands hereinabove described be and the same is hereby fixed at \$124.00, which includes \$25.00 for the land value and \$99.00 for the timber and that upon payment of the said amount by Pacific Power and Light Company, the right to overflow and perpetually back and hold water upon and over the lands covered by Application No. 26239 may be duly exercised in accordance with this grant.
