

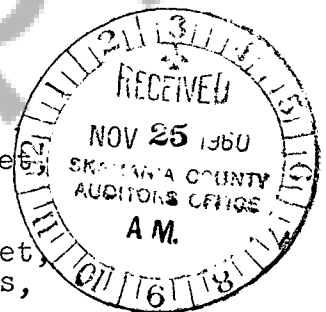
TIMBER DEED

WEYERHAEUSER COMPANY, a Washington corporation whose address is P. O. Box 1645, Tacoma 1, Washington, GRANTOR, in consideration of and in exchange for certain lands having a fair market value of Fifty-nine Thousand Two Hundred Fifty-five and no/100 Dollars (\$59,255.00) and being situated in Clark County and in Cowlitz County, Washington, convey and warrant unto WOODLAND TIE CO., a Washington corporation, whose address is Woodland, Washington, GRANTEE, the following described timber property having a fair market value of Fifty-nine Thousand Two Hundred Fifty-five and no/100 Dollars (\$59,255.00) and situated in Skamania County, Washington:

PARCEL I

ALL TIMBER, standing and down, EXCEPT green standing old growth yellow fir, situate upon that part of the Fractional East half of Northeast quarter (Fr. E $\frac{1}{2}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$) and of the Northeast quarter of Southeast quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Five (5), Township Seven (7) North, Range Five (5) East, W.M., lying within the following described tract:

Beginning at a point on the East line of said Section 5, which point is 1,980 feet North as measured along said East line from the Southeast corner of said Section 5; thence North 45° 00' West a distance of 1,634 feet; West a distance of 495 feet, North a distance of 825 feet, North 26° 30' East a distance of 1,476 feet, North a distance of 306 feet, more or less, to the North line of said Section 5, East along said North line a distance of 990 feet, more or less, to the Northeast corner of said Section 5, and South along said East line 3,606 feet, more or less, to the point of beginning; said tract containing 85.5 acres, more or less; and,

PARCEL II

ALL TIMBER, standing and down, EXCEPT green standing old growth yellow fir, situate upon the following described subdivisions in the Fractional West half (Fr. W $\frac{1}{2}$) of Section Five (5), Township Seven (7) North, Range Five (5) East, W.M.:

A portion of Lots 3 and 4 described as:
 Commencing at the Southwest corner of said
 Section 5; thence
 North along the West line of said Section 5
 a distance of 4,290 feet to the True Point
 of Beginning;
 thence East 1,980 feet,
 thence South parallel to said West line to the
 South line of said Lot 3,
 thence West along said South line to said West
 line,
 thence North along said West line to the True
 Point of Beginning; ALSO the

East half of West half of Southwest quarter of
 Northwest quarter ($E\frac{1}{2}$ of $W\frac{1}{2}$ of $SW\frac{1}{4}$ of $NW\frac{1}{4}$),
 East half of Southwest quarter of Northwest
 quarter ($E\frac{1}{2}$ of $SW\frac{1}{4}$ of $NW\frac{1}{4}$),
 West half of Southeast quarter of Northwest
 quarter ($W\frac{1}{2}$ of $SE\frac{1}{4}$ of $NW\frac{1}{4}$),
 West half of Northeast quarter of Southwest
 quarter ($W\frac{1}{2}$ of $NE\frac{1}{4}$ of $SW\frac{1}{4}$),
 East half of Northwest quarter of Southwest
 quarter ($E\frac{1}{2}$ of $NW\frac{1}{4}$ of $SW\frac{1}{4}$),
 East half of West half of Northwest quarter
 of Southwest quarter ($E\frac{1}{2}$ of $W\frac{1}{2}$ of $NW\frac{1}{4}$ of $SW\frac{1}{4}$),
 Southwest quarter of Southwest quarter
 ($SW\frac{1}{4}$ of $SW\frac{1}{4}$), and
 West half of Southeast quarter of Southwest
 quarter ($W\frac{1}{2}$ of $SE\frac{1}{4}$ of $SW\frac{1}{4}$),
 All of which described an area containing
 175.4 acres, more or less.

TOGETHER with rights to enter upon said land and remove said
 timber therefrom subject to certain rights of others as hereinafter
 indicated.

SUBJECT TO:

1. as to a portion of Parcel I:

Right of way for road as granted to Harbor Plywood Corporation by
 Weyerhaeuser Timber Company (now Weyerhaeuser Company) in instrument
 dated September 20, 1953. On February 14, 1958, Harbor Plywood
 Corporation assigned all of its interest in said right of way to
 International Paper Company.

2. as to a portion of Parcel I:

Right of way easement for road and electric transmission and tele-
 phone line as granted to the United States of America, Department
 of Agriculture, Forest Service, by Weyerhaeuser Timber Company (now
 Weyerhaeuser Company) by instrument dated September 2, 1955; use of
 said road is subject to contribution for or performance of maintenance.

3. as to a portion of Parcel I:

Right of way easement for road and electric transmission and telephone line as granted to the United States of America, Department of Agriculture, Forest Service, by Weyerhaeuser Timber Company (now Weyerhaeuser Company) by instrument dated May 27, 1958.
