## COMMUNITY PROPERTY AGREEMENT

This COMMUNITY PROPERTY AGREEMENT entered into this day by and between ANTHONY S. SMITH and PHYLLIS J. SMITH, husband and wife, of Stevenson in Skamania County, State of Washington:

Smith, for and in consideration of the love and affection which we have one for the other, do hereby mutually agree that all of the property which we now own separately, jointly or otherwise, and whether real, personal or otherwise, and situated in the State of Washington, shall be and it is hereby declared to be the community property of the parties, and each of the parties to this agreement does hereby convey and transfer to the other party and to the community, all property owned by them in the State of Washington, even though the same be held in his or her separate estate; and

We hereby mutually agree that all of the property which shall hereafter be acquired by either of us, whether separately, jointly or otherwise, and of whatso-ever nature and situated in the State of Washington, shall be and it is hereby declared to be community property, and each of the parties does hereby convey and transfer to the other and to the community all such property hereafter acquired by either of them, even though the same be acquired in his or her separate estate; and
