All such advances shall bear interest at the rate borne by the note which has the highest interest rate.
- (5) All advances by the Government as described in this instrument, with interest, shall be immediately due and payable by Borrower to the Government without demand at the place designated in the latest note and shall be secured hereby. No such advance by the Government shall relieve Borrower from breach of his covenant to pay. Such advances, with interest, shall be repaid from the first available collections received from Borrower. (10) To comply with all laws, ordinances, and regulations affecting the property.


