

AFFIDAVIT RE. COMMUNITY PROPERTY AGREEMENT

Walter S. Hilberg, being first duly sworn, on oath deposes and says:

That the affiant is the surviving spouse of Elva A. Hilberg who died at Vancouver, Washington, on September 21, 1958, having provided for the disposition of all community property as between affiant and the said deceased spouse under a community property agreement dated June 28, 1958.

That the said community property and survivorship agreement is being recorded in the office of the County Auditor for Skamania County concurrently with this affidavit.

That there are no creditors and no unpaid bills or debts of the said decedent or the marital community, nor any unpaid real estate contracts or mortgages.

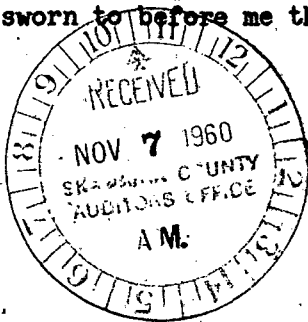
That the funeral expenses and all expenses of last illness of the said decedent have been fully paid.

That the value of the community estate as of the date of death, including all real and personal property was approximately \$176,550.75; and the value of all separate property of the said decedent was nothing as of the date of death; that the federal estate tax on the estate of the said decedent was finally determined in the amount of \$2,574.55 and has been paid; and that the inheritance tax on the said decedent's estate due to the state of Washington was finally determined in the total amount of \$1,675.50 and has been paid.

That a final release from the Inheritance Tax Division of the Tax Commission of the State of Washington, showing payment of inheritance tax in full, is being recorded simultaneously with this affidavit.

That at the time of the date of death of Elva A. Hilberg the affiant and Elva A. Hilberg were and had been for many years residents of Clark County, Washington.
