

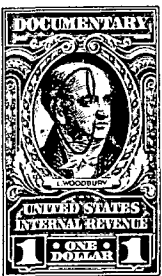


WARRANTY DEED

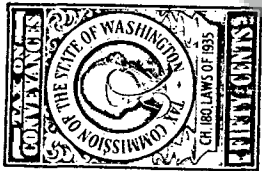
