TOGETHER WITH all furniture and fixtures on the above described premises except the dining room set and washing machine.

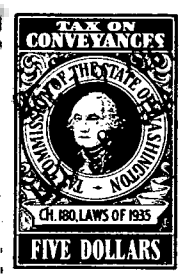
