

Reports have been received indicating that the selected lands are not valuable for minerals either metalliferous or nonmetalliferous.

The selected lands are not affected by any withdrawal adverse to this selection.

Therefore, and pursuant to Order No. 541, as amended July 28, 1955 (20 F.R. 5555), this list embracing 1280.00 acres is hereby approved subject to valid rights existing at date of selection; but excepting and reserving to the United States rights-of-way over and across the lands for ditches and canals constructed by the authority of the United States, as directed and required by the act of Congress approved August 30, 1890 (26 Stat. 391). Also reserving a right-of-way 60 feet wide across the SE1/4, Section 5, T. 12 N., R. 9 E., W.M., for a Forest Service road granted under Departmental Instructions of January 13, 1916 (44 L.D. 513).
