Section 821 of the Real Property Law expressly provides who shall receive the certificate of discharge in specific cases and also provides, among other things, that (1) no certificate shall purport to discharge more than one mortgage or even that may have been affected by instruments of cancellation, modification, or correction may be included in one certificate. If the instrument of discharge describes a particular mortgage, the title page of which has been assigned in whole or in part, the certificate shall set forth (2) the date of such instrument, (3) the name of the person or persons holding the certificate, (4) the name of the person or persons holding the certificate, (5) the date on which the instrument has been recorded, the book and page where it has been recorded or filed, and (6) if the instrument is being recorded simultaneously with the certificate of discharge, the certificate of discharge shall be recorded under the name of the mortgagor, and (7) if the mortgagor is held by any fiduciary, including an executor or administrator, the certificate of discharge shall recite the name of the court or other body holding the fiduciary in which his appointment was made or in which the order or decree vests him with such title & authority was entered.
