

NOTIFICATION OF LEASING
BY AND BETWEEN THE STATE OF WASHINGTON

and

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that the STATE OF WASHINGTON, acting by and through the Department of Natural Resources, hereinafter called the State, and WATER FRONT RECREATION, INC., a Washington corporation, hereinafter called the Lessee, have entered into a lease agreement whereby the State leases to the Lessee the following described school land in Skamania County, Washington, to-wit:

Government Lots 4 and 8, Section 26, Township 7 North, Range 6 East, W.M., having an area of 89.40 acres, more or less.

Subject, however, to an easement for right of way for access road acquired by the United States of America, United States Forest Service.

Said lease was granted the 11th day of August, 1970, as authorized under ROW 79.01.096. Said lease commences as of June 1, 1970, and continues until June 1, 2025. Said lease is subject to the terms and conditions set forth in that certain document executed as Lease No. 58595 by Lessee August 4, 1970 and by the State August 11, 1970.
