PROPERTY AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT made this _____ day of March, 1972 by and between BILLY B. O'NEAL, the Husband, and HARRIET R. O"NEAL, the Wife, residing at Willard, Washington, WITNESSETH:

Whereas, the parties were married on May 23, 1968, at Stevenson, Washington and have since resided and continue to reside at Willard, Washington, and

Whereas, each of the parties was previously married and acquired property prior to this marriage, and

Whereas, the parties desire to clarify their respective property ownerships for benefit of themselves and any future creditors of either,

NOW, THEREFORE, for valuable consideration, IT IS HEREBY AGREED between the parties as follows:

- (1) The Wife has property acquired prior to this marriage, or since as her separate property:
- (A) Furniture and furnishings as follows:

- (B) Bank accounts (checking account No. 58-362, savings account No. 71-829) in U. S. National Bank at Hood River, Oregon which were changed by wife to a joint account with husband (for convenience only) shortly after marriage. Such bank accounts shall hereafter be changed into joint tenancy accounts with wife's children
- (C) A 1972 Cherrolet Malibu standing in name of Wife and Rona 1 Halvorson (her son by prior marriage)

and Husband acknowledges that such property is Wife's sole and separate property and no community interest exists with rispect thereto.

- (2) The Husband had acquired prior to this marriage, or since as his separate property, the following described property:
 - (A) Furniture and furnishings as follows:

Table lamp
2 chests of drawers
Complete single bed
Blonde double bed (no mattress or spring)
Blonde dresser

and Wiff acknowledges the foregoing to be Husband's sole and separate property

(3) The parties have acquired since their marriage as their community property a Westinghouse washer and dryer, a 1965 Ford Mustang automobile, a Zenith color television set and have and maintain a checking account with the First National Bank of Oregon at Hood River, Oregon, carried in joint names of both parties.

Neither party shall have the right to obligate or in any way impose a security interest on the separate property of the other spouse without the express prior written consent of such other party and each spouse does herewith agree with the other to make disclosure to any future creditors of the separate character of such property if necessary to prevent any apparent reliance of any creditor upon such property as evidence of financial worth or resources.

All of the community property above-described in Para(3) Aforesaid or hereafter acquired, shall, upon the death of either of the aforementioned parties, immediately vest in fee simple in the survivor of them.
