4.02 Condition of Site. The premises hereby leased have been inspected by Lessee and are accepted in

4.03 Vehicles. No vehicles shall be parked in roadway. Vehicles shall not be operated carelessly or in excess of posted speeds. No vehicle shall be operated at any time without a muffler in good working order. Excessive motor noise or annoying smoke are forbidden.

4.04 Maintenance. All lots shall at all times be kept in a clean, sightly, and wholesome condition and no trash, parbage, litter, lunk, boxes, containers, bottles, cans, machiners, implements, lumber, or other building materials shall be permitted to be or romain exposed on any lo and visible from any street or adjoining or nearby premise.

4.05 Signs. No class of any kind shall be displayed to the public view on any lot in the tract except one pro) sair at sign, of not more than 18 inches by 24 inches in 3.22, advertising the property for sale or rent, and except significated by a builder or developer to advertise the property during the con truction and sales period.

4.15 Solia tetion. There shall be no solicitation or distribution of handbills or circulation of any kind withcar the written consent of Lestor.

4.16 Hose P.lbs. One hose bib shall be installed on cutside well of each cabin for fire protection on or before completion of the cable.

SECTION 6. IMPROVEMENTS

5.01 Plans Approved. No building shall be erected, placed, or altered on the cabin site until the construction plans showing the location of the structure have been approved by the Legar as to conform by with plan of development, quality of workmanship and materials, harmony of external design and color with existing structures, and as to location with respect to topography and finish grade elevation. Such approval shall be in writing.

5.02 Building Materials. All building construction shall be of log or wood frame. Wood frame stucco or simulated brick veneer construction is expressly prohibiter. 5.03 Completion. Cabins must be completed from all outmost appearance within one (1) year from the time such construction is started. Cabin construction must be carted within this eyears from the date of the signing of Cabin Site Lease.

5.0. Tree Removal. The Lessee of each cabin site may remove from said-site all trees, shrubs, and folloge necessary to prepare the property for building subject to the following conditions:

As required by the State of Washington in the master lease, any tree whose dismeter is over 8" at chest height must be marked by Lessee for Lesser's inspection. Lessor will then notify the Washington State Department of Natural Resources and request their standard appraisal of value. Lessee will then pay Lessor for the value of the tree before removal. Any additional clearing beyond that necessary for the construction of its provement: shall be prohibited. The intent is to remove as few trees as possible to the end that the community retain natural and rustic.

8.02 Reservation. Lessor reserves to itra' and to its successors and assigns assements in, under, and alc gall roads and other common areas in the plat for way utilities whether presently installed or not. In addition, in ease-ment is reserved in an area five (6) feet by ten (10) feet in one corner of each for (to be selected by Lessor) adjoining the road, for electric transformer vault and/or telephone and power service pedestals if any. Such insurance shall be carried by a responsible company or companies satisfactory to Lessor and the policy or policies shall be endorsed and delivered to Lessor with provision for thirty (30) days'

(b) Liability and property insurance insuring Lessor and Lessee against all liability for damages to persons or property caused by the maintenance, use or occupancy of the leased provises or by reason of the conduct of any activity carried on therein. Such insurance shall be carried by a responsible company or companies satisfactory to Lessor in amounts not less than the following limits, pamely:

Bodily injury to or death of any one person, \$5,000.60;

7.04 Assignment. Without the prior written consent of Lessor, Lessee shall not assign this lease or any Interest therein, or sublet, and no heir, executor, administrator, receiver, trustee in bankruptcy or other assignce by operation of law shall assign or sublease without such written consent

7.05 Waiver Any waiver by the Lessor of any provisions hereof must be in writing, and any of the covenants, conditions, restrictions, in this lease may be annulled, waived, changed, or modified with respect to all or any portion

7.06 Attorneys' Feet. In the event any action, suit, proceeding or appeal therefrom is brought to collect the rent due or to become due hereunder, or any portion thereof, or to get possession of said premises, or to inforce compliance with this lease, or for failure to observe any of the covenants of this lease, the prevailing party shall be entitled to recover such sum as the Court may adjudge reasonable as attorneys' fees to be allowed in said ruit, action, proceeding or appeal therefrom in addition to such other relief granted by the Court.

7.07 Concemnation. 7.08 Reservoir Level. The Lessee acknowledges by signing this lease that Pacific Power and Light Company has the right to fluctuate the waters of Swift Reservoir at any time within the provisions of Federal Power Commission License No. 2111 or as amended. The Lessee shall waive all claims or damage and shall indemnify Pacific Power and Light Company, the State of Washington, Lessor or their successors, if any, against any claim of damage arising from fluctuation in reservoir level or impairment of recreational use of the reservoir or shoreside or floating facilities.

7.09 Validity of Provisions. The determination of any Court that any provisions of this lease are unawful or void shall not affect the validity of any other provision hereof.

7.10 Enforcement of Restrictions. Without in any way limiting the rights of Lessor, if the parties upon whom the provisions hereof are binding, or any of them, shall violate or attempt to violate any of the reservations, resurfacempliance with the provisions hereof, to abate and remove, at the expense of the offending lessee or lessees of the property, violation of the provisions hereof, to exceedings at law or in equity in furtherance of the aforesaid remedies in any Court having jurisdiction of such case.
