

ASSIGNMENT OF PAGE

FOR AND IN CONSIDERATION of love, affection and devotion, LYLE GREGORY, on behalf of the Congregation of Jehovah's Witnesses, of North Bonnaville, Washington, hereinafter referred to as the "Congregation", does hereby assign all of the Congregation's right, title and interest in and to that certain lease made and executed by and between Donald A. Brown, party of the first part, and the Congregation of Jehovah's Witnesses, of North Bonnaville, Washington, party of the second part, dated the 1st day of September, 1969, covering the following described real property situate in North Bonnaville, Shavanna County, Washington, to-wit:

A plot of ground beginning at a point twenty-three feet (23') east of the west border line of the Brown Tract; thence running eastward one hundred (100') feet along the north line of the lot of the late James Sumner Street; thence northward one hundred twenty-five feet (125'); thence westward one hundred feet (100'); thence southward one hundred twenty-five feet (125') to the point of beginning; more or less the area known as Block No. Two (2), situated in the Green Tract, a part of the old Thoronith estate land and also beginning at a point in the north line of State Road No. 8, three hundred and twenty feet (320') west of Section line between sections numbered one (1) and two (2), and running two (2), Townsh's Two (2) North, Range South 11 West of the 121st meridian 1. Skaneateles County, Twp. 1 North.
